SIR of the Month

Henry Andrew Tukloff Jr. was born 1936 in West Chester, Pennsylvania. He graduated from the local high school in 1954. After graduation, Henry and six of his high school friends joined the United States Army National Guard for eight years. Henry left the Guard with the rank of E-7 SFC. After the Guard, Henry went to work as a Carpenter, then became a Correctional Officer and then a Police Officer.

Henry moved to California in August of 1961. He attended Fresno City College for a year and then went back to work building houses. He started off as a Carpenter, then became a Superintendent and finally was promoted to Estimator until he resigned in March of 1966.



Henry then moved to San Jose, California where he attended San Jose City College and received an AA degree. After City College, Henry transferred to San Jose State University receiving a BA in 1969 and a teaching credential the same year. He began teaching in 1970 while also attending night classes at San Jose State University where he received his MA degree.

In 1974, Henry joined the United States Army Reserves which was a general hospital called the 347th. Henry became the first Sergeant E-8. In 1980, Henry became a Warrant Officer and retired in 1996 from the Army Reserves as a Chief Warrant Officer 3.

Henry and his wife Donna purchased a retirement home in Auburn, California in 2000. They were part time residents until 2005 when Donna retired from teaching. They moved to Auburn full time in June 2005 when Henry joined SIRS branch 37.

Sir Henry served as Big Sir twice, once in 2010 and once in 2012. He served as a Director for six years, was the leader of Patriotism/Pledge, was the Song Leader, and served on the Nominating Committee for seven years. Henry was responsible for acquiring the sign out in front of the Elks Club showing a man with his fly-fishing rod and has also donated money over the years to Branch 37.


